The purpose of the conference: implementation of a comprehensive scientific discussion of the current state of research in the field of economics, science and education in the conditions of cross-border cooperation; providing a platform for the free exchange of opinions and research results on solving the problems of the development of the Danube macro-region.

Doctors and candidates of sciences, teachers, doctoral students, post-graduate students and master's degree applicants of higher education institutions of Ukraine and abroad are invited to participate in the conference.

Discussions are planned in the following areas:

- Strategy of the European Union for the economy of the region: implementation tools;
- Strategic aspects in managing the development of entrepreneurial activity in the conditions of cross-border cooperation;

FORMAT REQUIREMENTS

*The text submitted should be 5 – 6 pages in length; A4 (240*297 mm) page format; in MS Word with extension *.docx, *.doc or *.rtf; Times New Roman font, left, right, top, bottom margins - 20 mm; size 12 pt, 1.0 interval, 1 cm paragraph indentation.*

The required structural elements of the text: introduction, main part, conclusions.

Structural elements **shouldn't be pointed**.

The code number UDC (ordinary print) is to be given on the first line before the name of the author/s in the left hand corner. The following paragraph – is the title of the article in capital letters, below is the first and the last name of the author/s (the number of the authors no more than three) in the English language, with reference to the author's/s' information details in the form of comment. The following paragraph – is the title of the article in capital letters, below is the first and the last name of the author/s (the number of the authors no more than three) in the Ukrainian language, with reference to the author's/s' information details in the form of comment.

N.B.! Brief author's/s' information details are to be given in the form of comment to the author's/s' last name with the help of “Superscript” function: the ordinal number of the comment is indicated (e.g. ...¹ ...²), and below the text of the article under the title “Comments” the necessary information is given in the English and Ukrainian languages (academic degree, academic rank, position, place of work, contact details with the indication of the author's ORCID).

The following paragraph – is the text of the abstract (250-300 cpl), the key words (5-7) in the English and Ukrainian languages. On the next line the text of the article is given. “List of references” should be given after the text in the order of their appearance in the text. The references to the sources used in the text are given according to the model [2, p. 364; 5, p. 127; 7-9], where the first number is the number of the source in the list of references, then, after the comma, goes the number of the page; several sources are given with the semi-colon or hyphen. The bibliographic description of the literary sources is given according to the DSTU 8302:2015 requirements.

The graphic material should be performed in the programs available for further editing. For pictures and tables it is necessary to use *Times New Roman* font, size 11 pt, 1.0 interval, black-and- white gamma scale, the description is given below the picture, full justification. The tables should have the title and number in Arabic figures, in one line with its title. The tables in horizontal format (broad size) are not accepted. The broad size of the table should not exceed the broad size of the text. Mathematic formulas are presented in Microsoft Equation Editor. Besides publishing in the text, all pictures, tables, photos should be submitted in a separate file. Scanned (photocopied) tables and pictures are not accepted. Word division (including automatic) is not accepted.

N.B.! The articles of postgraduate students and master's degree students should be submitted together with their scientific advisor's review or the department's review and recommendation for publishing, certified with the seal of the educational establishment or other establishment.

The files of the participant should be named in accordance with his surname and initials, e.g.: *Article_Olijnyk.doc*; *Application_Olijnyk.doc*.

The electronic conference program, the collection of the scientific materials and the certificate of participation will be also sent to all participants to their e-mail address.

Population censuses are one of the key sources in the study of ethnodemographic processes and the ethnosocial structure of the population of the country or its individual region. In the Russian Empire, the general population census was conducted only in 1897, and the main forms of statistical population accounting in the first half of the 19th century. there were revision censuses of taxable estates, metric books and current administrative and police population records. The first census of the population of Bessarabia was conducted in 1817, at the same time as the population was made to swear allegiance to the emperor [1, p. 23]...
